

6TH GRADE SOLO CONTEST

WHO AND WHAT:

- All 6th Grade band students (excluding percussionists) will perform a solo, one-on-one, with a judge on this day. Solo time slots are approximately 5 minutes.
- After each performance, one of our highly skilled judges will give educational feedback to performer(s).
- Each performance will get a score sheet and ranking of 1 – 3 based on the quality of their performance.
- Outstanding soloist awards will be selected by the judges at the end of the day.

WHEN AND WHERE:

- The contest is hosted at HPMS. You will park and enter the school on High School Ave.
- Individual solo and ensemble performance times will be assigned by Friday, March 29th.
- The time commitment for the day is typically 45 minutes.
- Students should arrive 30 minutes prior to their performance time in order to warm-up. They should be outside their assigned room 5 minutes prior to their performance.
- Once students have performed both their solo and ensemble, they are done for the day!

DRESS:

- Students should dress professionally for this event. No shorts, t-shirts or athletic shoes should be worn.

CAN PARENTS COME?:

- Yes! Parents are encouraged to be here on that day. While we do not have parents in the room during the performance, you can stand outside the door and hear your child's performance!
